**Minutes:**

The applicant was present, accompanied by MAT TAHAT, a Court Interpreter of Arabic.

BARRY REININK, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Special Investigations, noted  
that this item had been tabled at its last hearing in order to accommodate the applicant's court  
date. He stated that at the August 14th court hearing, the applicant pleaded guilty to gross  
lewdness, a gross misdemeanor. MAYOR GOODMAN added that the Court had ordered the  
applicant to surrender his business license, pending sentencing.

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: AUGUST 20, 2008**

MR. TAHAT read MR. ALSMADI'S written statement in which MR. ALSMADI said that, after his arrest and revocation of his license, his life had been ruined. MR. ALSMADI asked for the work permit because he was losing his house and could not support his family because he could not make a living.

MAYOR GOODMAN responded that MR. ALSMADI'S guilty plea had forfeited his right to a work card.

COUNCILMAN REESE noted that the Mayor and the Council had the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Confidential Report and understood the charges to which MR. ALSMADI had pleaded guilty.
