- Whereas;** The city of Las Vegas is committed to sustainability efforts and was recognized for its environmental practices at the World Leadership Awards in London, England, where it was named American City of the Year; and
- Whereas;** Union Park, a 61-acre mixed-use master-planned urban center located in the heart of downtown Las Vegas being developed by the city of Las Vegas and Newland Communities, will be one of the biggest examples of "green" development in the state of Nevada; and
- Whereas;** Union Park was the only project in Nevada to be accepted into the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design, or LEED®, Neighborhood Development national pilot program; and
- Whereas;** Union Park has been awarded stage two Gold certification status, the second highest level of certification, under the LEED® green building rating system, which evaluates communities on criteria related to smart location and linkage to the community at large; neighborhood pattern and design; green construction and technology; and water and energy conservation; and
- Whereas;** Union Park will serve as an example for residents and businesses alike to undergo practices that will meet the needs of our current community without compromising the needs of future generations; now
- Therefore;** I, THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, HEREBY PROUDLY PROCLAIM SEPTEMBER 3, 2008 TO BE:
