PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Detention and Enforcement eliminated its K-9 program. NDPS indicated an interest in adopting Evita and Bronco for use as police dogs. Evita, Bronco and some associated K-9 equipment will be transferred from City of Las Vegas to NDPS at the cost of \$2,500. This will be a substantial savings to NDPS instead of purchasing new K-9 dogs.
