PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This request is to allow an 8-inch Polyvinylchloride (PVC) waterline to be placed in the public right-of-way. The waterline will lay 3.5-feet underground beginning under the Ogden Avenue right-of-way on the south side of the building extending westward for 30-feet and continuing northward under the public alley (on the west side of the building) for an additional 27-feet where it will connect to the building to provide required fire protection for the proposed Ogden House Hotel. If approved, the applicant will be required to sign an Encroachment Agreement that has conditions of maintenance, liability and removal.
