Minutes:

DOROTHY BAKER stated that her situation and problems with the police persist, noting that nothing changes in this town. She felt that living conditions were regressing to those during the Great Depression. Also, she expressed concern about the health and safety of the people.

TOM MCGOWAN, Las Vegas resident, placed a document on the overhead and described his proposed plan for a project that would utilize renewable energy and include various uses that would undoubtedly become world class attractions, including a hospital dedicated to the highest quality. He noted that people have to strive for the best.

TED RUSSELL, Las Vegas resident, mentioned that, ironically, damage caused to petroleum refineries during hurricane seasons is beneficial to the Southwest, which is at the vanguard in developing renewal energy technologies. He pointed out that SENATOR HARRY REID was repeatedly writing articles for the Las Vegas Sun regarding the great future of the Southwestern United States. MR. RUSSELL advised the Council that he was writing a cover letter for his proposed 28th Amendment, was working to organize an academics Olympics in an attempt to stimulate America to be more academically competitive and was profusely studying the Federalist Papers to put together a plan for the United States that would replicate the greatest nation in history.

MAYOR GOODMAN announced that homeless individuals could obtain assistance by contacting the City.
