No motion required. A presentation was made.

MAYOR GOODMAN invited CHIEF FAREN COYNE, Director, Detention and Enforcement Department, to join him at the podium to recognize JAMES WULFF as the September Employee of the Month. MAYOR GOODMAN stated that MR. WULFF joined the City as part of the Streets and Sanitation Division in April 2005 and subsequently obtained a promotion in the Detention and Enforcement Department in October 2006.

MAYOR GOODMAN recognized his great work ethic, noting MR. WULFFS efforts to initiate the first recycling program in the Citys Detention Maintenance Shop. He also highlighted MR. WULFFS recent work to find efficient ways to conserve City resources, including his recent project to refit the inmate housing units cell rooms, resulting in a decrease in the electrical parts budget by 50 percent and a reduction in the fixture change out time by more than a year. MAYOR GOODMAN added that MR. WULFF volunteers at several childrens camps in his spare time.

CHIEF COYNE stated that MR. WULFF came to the City with a positive attitude and great ambition which has led to his achievements. She stated that the Detention and Enforcement Department consumes a lot of water as part of its operations and noted the many opportunities to find further cost savings for the department. She recognized NANCY WULFF, MR. WULFFS mother, for teaching a great work ethic and several admirable skills to her son. CHIEF COYNE also congratulated MR. WULFF for his nomination by his colleagues, pointing out that recognition by his co-workers was a distinct honor.

MR. WULFF was pleased to work with the City and appreciated the recognition. MS. WULFF described her sons hobbies and interests, stressing that he was a very eligible bachelor.
