Minutes:

Prior to an update given by JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, COUNCILMAN BARLOW clarified that the subject site is located adjacent to the site location for the previous item number 71.

JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, read into the record the previous conditions that were approved. During the last six months, the number of service calls has decreased by one and are spread throughout the day and not within a specific timeframe. Previous inspections have found that security has been on site, there is no loitering and only a minor violation relative to having an employee list readily available upon request. In addition, the applicant has acted as security personnel in addition to the hired security. The hours of operation have been consistent.

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MR. DiFIORE believes the applicant has been more proactive and responsible in operating his business. It was his recommendation to maintain the current conditions and leave it to the Council's discretion to add conditions and/or make changes to the current business hours which are 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Sunday through Thursday, and 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Friday and Saturday.

THAMER JARJEES, 1602 H Street, noted his efforts to maintain the business and alleviate any loitering issues.

Since his previous conversation with MR. JARJEES, COUNCILMAN BARLOW acknowledged that the loitering has decreased significantly and was pleased with his efforts. Given the new hours of operation for the previous item, he is concerned with the impact upon MR. JARJEES' business and such progress may be reversed. He looks forward to working with MR. JARJEES in maintaining his progress and chose to keep the current hours of operation with a six-month review to address any issues that may arise.

MR. JARJEES added that his security personnel sometimes remain overnight to ensure the property remains clean and free from abandoned vehicles. He appreciated the Councilman's support and approval.
