NOTE: COUNCILMAN WOLFSON disclosed for Item 113 that he would recuse himself because, as an attorney, he had appeared and may appear before the applicant, who serves as an alternate judge for the courts. ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY SCOTT opined that COUNCILMAN WOLFSON could vote on an abeyance motion.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW announced that DR. DOWNEY, who wanted to speak on Item 113, is his child's pediatrician, but he would be participating.

After the vote on Items 91-99, MAYOR GOODMAN made the following disclosure for Items 101-104 at the request of ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY SCOTT: He has a partnership interest in APEX, along with ANDREW LEVY, one of the applicants on Items 101-104; therefore, he was advised to abstain. ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY SCOTT clarified that the Mayor could vote on the abeyance motion, but he would have to abstain when the applications are heard by the Council.

**Minutes:**

Regarding Item 113, LOU CHRISTIAN, 2060 Diamond Bar Drive, questioned the number of times an item for consideration by the City Council could be held in abeyance, pointing out that many people had to take time off work to attend this meeting. COUNCILMAN WOLFSON explained that he was made aware of the request that morning and noted that this was the first time the matter was being considered by the City Council.

MAYOR GOODMAN announced that he would allow people to make comments on Item 113, but those people would not be allowed to speak at the abeyance date of 11/5/2008.
