Minutes:

RASHAN JOSHUA COLLINS read a portion of one of GEORGE WASHINGTON'S private prayers and noted that this country was founded on good morals, but its people became perverted and without any regard for the law.

SHERMAN RUTLEDGE referenced packets he sent the Councilmembers regarding his Student Ambassador Program, designed to keep youth out of trouble and orient them to math, science, and technology. He urged the Councilmembers to review the packet and support his program.

JOHN WEBER said he was present for Item 64, but decided to stay and express opposition to anymore pawnshops being allowed to operate, noting that they are places for thieves to pawn stolen goods.

DENNIS STONEY, Las Vegas resident, questioned the need for so many gasoline stations and drug stores that later fail and leave vacant buildings and jobless people. He pointed out that many of them are approved despite staffs recommendation for denial.

TED RUSSELL, Las Vegas resident, said that people consider him to be a vagrant, but he assured the Council that he would be responsible for the creation of millions of jobs and for the provision of the seven elements to enable this world to continue.
