COUNCILMAN BARLOW has driven by the subject location and believes the business will do well.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN verified with MSYOR GOODMAN that the business is freestanding and located east of Shadow Lane. She recalled the business being highly praised and preferred by local reporters.

MS. MEYER clarified that staff's recommendation is temporary approval only for both items, 50 and 51.
