MAYOR PRO TEM REESE declared the Public Hearing open.

TIMOTHY VOLZ thanked the Council for allowing the tower, which was very useful during hurricane Gustav, and apologized for not having finalized everything sooner. He did not realize a third inspection was needed and did not keep records of time the antenna was retracted.

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JUANITA CLARK, Charleston Preservation, expressed support of the tower as it is very useful.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN stated that she has received several complaints from neighbors who feel the antenna is interfering with TV reception. She preferred holding this matter until 4/15/2009 when all homes should have digital TV, which may improve reception.

MR. VOLZ did not believe the antenna was causing interference, but agreed to the abeyance. However, he requested concerned neighbors contact him for assistance.
