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23 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

24 Item 54 is discussion and possible action regarding an Appeal of Denial of a Bail Bond Agency  
25 License and a Bail Agent License for VIP Bail Bonds at two locations at 8725 West Flamingo  
26 Road in the County and 3100 East Lake Mead Boulevard, Suite 20, in the City of North Las  
27 Vegas for Nakia Woodson. And, Mr. DiFiore.

28

29 **JIM DiFIORE**

30 Mayor and Members of the Council, this item today is not ward specific, as you – will see here  
31 on the agenda item. The applications that we have before us are two; one for a Business License  
32 in Clark County and one for a Business License in North Las Vegas. The Appeal submitted by  
33 Ms. Woodson originally was for the first denial, which was the County location, and the reason  
34 we're hearing these with a County and a North Las Vegas location is because she is attempting  
35 to conduct business in the City and our Code requires you have a business license if you are  
36 going to conduct business in the City.

37 Now, the first Appeal was going to be heard November 5<sup>th</sup>, but in the mean time circumstances  
38 led me to deny the second application, and I felt it was prudent for the Council to hear these  
39 appeals all at – once on the same agenda item.

40 The November, I'm sorry, the County location of 8725 West Flamingo Road address was denied  
41 on September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2008. It is actually Exhibit No. 2 in your booklet. Ms. Woodson also has a  
42 copy of that particular booklet. There were three reasons why that license was denied, and I'll  
43 go through these briefly.

44 The applicant was denied based upon the fact that she did not meet the criteria of a State  
45 requirement, NRS 697.280, where it states every Bail Agent shall have and maintain in the State  
46 a place of business accessible to the public wherein the licensee principally conducts transactions  
47 under this license.

48 The 8725 West Flamingo Road address for her business is actually a condominium in a gated  
49 community, her residence, and I didn't believe it met the criteria under that particular statute.  
50 The second reason for the denial was due to the fact that she conducted, carried on, engaged,  
51 advertised in a trade or profession, without obtaining a valid business license.

52

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53 In this particular case, Ms. Woodson was previously operating from 1203 West Owens, moved  
54 to 1360 West Owens earlier this year, applied for a business license later in the year, but went  
55 before the City Council on August 6<sup>th</sup> for a Special Use Permit and was denied that Special Use  
56 Permit to operate from 1360 West Owens.

57 We have evidence in the packet here, under Exhibit No. 4, which have been submitted to me by  
58 the Las Vegas Municipal Court, where she has posted bail bond contracts on several occasions:  
59 August 11<sup>th</sup>, August 29<sup>th</sup>, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, September 4<sup>th</sup>, September 7<sup>th</sup>, September 9<sup>th</sup> and  
60 September 11<sup>th</sup>, which we are submitting as evidence to prove that she was conducting business  
61 in the City of Las Vegas during those dates and without a valid business license at that time.

62 Lastly, under this denial, she was denied based upon the fact that we would consider her a public  
63 nuisance, in that on July 16<sup>th</sup>, Judge, Municipal Court Judge Cedric Kerns, barred her from  
64 appearing in his Municipal Court No. 5. When the evidence provided that was found that she  
65 violated more than one provision of State Law in the issuance of several bonds, including  
66 charging excessive fees. These findings also found that she included a fraudulent use of a State  
67 notary stamp.

68 With me today is Deputy City Attorney Martin Orsinelli, who provided the City's representation  
69 at Judge Kerns' hearing on July 16<sup>th</sup> and is very, very familiar with the background of – his  
70 decision. Skipping forward to the second application, which is found in Exhibit 10.

71

72 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

73 I know.

74

75 **JIM DiFIORE**

76 Exhibit 10 is a business license application for 3100 East Lake Mead Boulevard, Suite No. 20.  
77 Exhibit 11 is a certified letter dated November 5, 2008, which also denies this business license  
78 application, much for the same reason as the previous application was denied. Additionally  
79 though, there was a reason for denial based upon an Order provided by Municipal Court Judge  
80 Bert Brown on October 20<sup>th</sup>, which –

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81 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

82 (Inaudible)

83

84 **JIM DiFIORE**

85 – essentially supported Judge Kerns’ decision in July. Additionally, the motion that was made  
86 on October 20<sup>th</sup>, or September 18<sup>th</sup>, with a decision on October 20<sup>th</sup>, Judge Brown’s decision,  
87 barred Ms. Woodson from appearing in any Municipal Court until June 30<sup>th</sup> of 2009. I believe at  
88 that time she’ll have an opportunity to appeal that particular barring of those courtrooms and  
89 will, and may be able to reappear back in Municipal Court. It may be taken under consideration  
90 at that point. However, again, Deputy City Attorney Orsinelli is here with any questions that  
91 you may have on any of the Orders that – are a part of this packet.

92 For those reasons, I’m asking the City Council to uphold my denial of her business license  
93 applications to conduct business in the City of Las Vegas.

94

95 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

96 All right, fine. Thank you. Any questions of Mr. DiFiore at this time? Ms. Woodson.

97

98 **NAKIA WOODSON**

99 Good afternoon, Mayor. Good afternoon, Council Members. I’m here to humbly request that  
100 you grant me a business license. There are several reasons. The first is this hearing is not  
101 timely. I initially submitted my Appeal September 26<sup>th</sup>. I was then told to submit it to City  
102 Clerk. I did that. I then resubmitted it again, finally to Mr. DiForie (sic), October the 10<sup>th</sup>, after  
103 he was well aware that the initial Appeal was done September the 26<sup>th</sup>. According to Las Vegas  
104 Municipal Code 6.02.110, it clearly states that at the expiration of those ten days, I should be at a  
105 Council hearing. I should have been at the hearing, October 22<sup>nd</sup>. I’m not sure why I was  
106 delayed til today.

107 The second reason is, at all times, I have had a business license. I have a letter here from Mr.  
108 DiForie (sic) dated August 25<sup>th</sup> of 2008 for it clearly states, business license fees are paid in  
109 advance so you were required to pay for business license fees for the 1363 West Owens Avenue

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110 business location. So it has always been my contention that I have had a license in all  
111 jurisdictions in Southern Nevada. This is the letter from Mr. DiForie (sic).

112 Third, this Appeal is for the 8725 West Flamingo address only. I have not submitted an appeal  
113 for the North Las Vegas address.

114 The next thing: There's several inaccuracies in Mr. DiForie's (sic) letter dated September 22<sup>nd</sup>.  
115 Again, on the first page, he says VIP Bail Bonds has never obtained a valid license for this  
116 location. Well, that's in con (sic), that contradicts his letter, August 25<sup>th</sup>, of why I paid business  
117 license fees for 1363 West Owens. So again, it's my position that I had a license at that address.

118 The second inaccuracy in his letter, page 2, it says, these findings included use of fraudulent use  
119 of your notary stamp. There's nowhere indicated in this entire file that there was fraudulent use  
120 of my personal notary stamp.

121 The third thing: He said, additionally, you have continued to advertise and/or conduct business  
122 without a valid business license from 1363 Owens and 8725 West Flamingo. Again, that's  
123 inaccurate. As stated, this letter here says that the fees that I paid in June was for 1363 West  
124 Owens. In addition, 8725 West Flamingo is Clark County. I have the business license here from  
125 Clark County for that address. Clark County has been aware at all times that it was a home-  
126 based business.

127 Okay, the next reason: What brings us here today is at the last Council Meeting on August 6<sup>th</sup>, it  
128 was made clear that Councilman Barlow did not want me in his Ward. We've talked about a lot  
129 of things here today. We've talked about being adversaries with the City; we've talked about the  
130 economy; we've talked about our future. I'm not trying to be an adversary with the City, so I  
131 made a business decision to move out of the City of Las Vegas. I have two addresses with Clark  
132 County and a second address with the City of North Las Vegas. All of this has been reported to  
133 the Division of Insurance. I don't see any letter documentation here from the Division of  
134 Insurance that denies that, so I am in compliance with the State of Nevada and the Division of  
135 Insurance.

136 Also, I think that the City should allow the other entities to do their job. We're pointing fingers  
137 here. We're talking about the West Flamingo address. If Clark County issued a license and does  
138 not have a problem with that, if I've reported this address to DOI, of which I have the

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139 documentation here, I'm not understanding why the City is worried about what other entities are  
140 doing.

141 As far as the Court is concerned, I did not know that I was coming here for a court hearing today.  
142 Possibly, I should have brought Counsel. I don't understand why the City Attorney is here.  
143 Secondly, what Mr. DiForie (sic) failed to point out to you, I've never been convicted of a  
144 criminal action and at this time, the Judge's decision is on appeal. This is currently a, pending in  
145 Court. The last time I stood before you, Mr. Barlow pulled out a citation that I was given August  
146 1<sup>st</sup> stating that I didn't have a license. Okay. That has been dismissed. I never went to Court on  
147 that. They threw it out. So it seems to me, every time I'm before City Council, I'm not allowed  
148 my day in court. So it's basically, I'm guilty before a judge can make the decision.

149 So, what I can say is that I've complied with everything. I moved out of Ward 5. I have a valid  
150 address in Clark County, 8725 West Flamingo, a valid address in North Las Vegas. In addition,  
151 the judge's decision is on Appeal. I'm a divorced mother of two children, the economy is bad,  
152 like we all said today. I'm not trying to be an adversary with the City, which is why I moved  
153 out. I didn't dispute that. So being that I'm not located in the City any more, I would like to  
154 have my license and continue to do business with the City. And I have brought members here in  
155 support today, if you'll allow them a couple of minutes to say something in support of me in the  
156 business.

157

158 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

159 Fine. I'm going to just say this while you can bring your witnesses up. Folks, it's about five  
160 after one now. At the conclusion of the morning agenda, we have a Special Personnel Session,  
161 so we'll be working in Chambers on the Personnel Session and I just don't see us coming back  
162 here if we keep on going the way we're going before, I say 2:15. So, if you can do something  
163 with that time to your advantage, I'm just giving you notice that we'll probably reconvene,  
164 assuming we wrap up reasonably quickly on the morning agenda, at 2:15. I may be overly  
165 optimistic. All right, one minute apiece, gentlemen, please. Please tell us your name and your  
166 address.

167

168 **REVEREND COVINGTON**

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169 Reverend Covington, 1705 Yale Street, Mr. Mayor and Councilmen. Mr. Mayor, you look good.

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170 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

171 You look good.

172

173 **REVEREND COVINGTON**

174 Thank you. Not as young as I used to be.

175

176 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

177 But you look better than you used to.

178

179 **REVEREND COVINGTON**

180 Thank you.

181

182 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

183 You're welcome.

184

185 **REVEREND COVINGTON**

186 We're here on behalf of Mrs. Woodson. As we know the economy is what it is and a mother of  
187 two childrens (sic) trying to work. We're here in support of her, and we're asking for a  
188 consideration –

189

190 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

191 Thank you.

192

193 **REVEREND COVINGTON**

194 – on the part of the Council.

195

196 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

197 Thank you very much. Yes, Sir.

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198 **MAURICE SHOWERS**

199 Good morning Mr. Mayor and City Council. Maurice Showers, 5180 Burnham Avenue. I'm  
200 here in support of Nakia Woodson. I know she's a hard working and industrious young lady and  
201 given the opportunity to do the right thing, I know she will comply with whatever is required,  
202 and we ask you that you will allow her to continue her livelihood and support her family.

203

204 **NAKIA WOODSON**

205 And, Your Honor –

206

207 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

208 Wait. (Inaudible)

209

210 **NAKIA WOODSON**

211 – can I just add one last point? I did want to be clear that in all other jurisdictions I'm posting  
212 bail on, everything is fine. So again, there only seems to be an issue with the City of Las Vegas.  
213 I'm trying to get that resolved today. Again, I don't want to have an adversarial relationship.

214

215 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

216 I appreciate that.

217

218 **NAKIA WOODSON**

219 I have no other problems in the other jurisdictions.

220

221 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

222 Fine. Yes, Sir.

223

224 **JAMES COTRAINE**

225 Good afternoon. James Cotraine, Chief Operating Officer for World Events Services, LLC. I  
226 am here as a business partner, and I ask that you all grant her her business license. Consider the  
227 fact that you all are trying to boost the economy, bring people here from around the world and I

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228 work as a, and that service is bringing people here and around the world and do business here  
229 with Ms. Woodson. So, I respectfully request that you will honor her request.

230

231 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

232 Thank you.

233

234 **ROLANDO LARRAZ**

235 Good afternoon. My name is Rolando Larraz. I'm the owner, sole owner, of the Las Vegas  
236 Tribune newspaper. I'm a victim of Mr. DiFiore, and I believe than a, what happening with Ms.  
237 Woodson, is some kind of a discrimination. Somehow, somewhere, if you read Las Vegas  
238 Tribune this week, you gonna see what my editorial is because I was accused of making a  
239 million dollars in profit in 2006, and I was forced to move out of the City where I was very  
240 happy, and I was very proud and very honorable of being the downtown newspaper. Mr.  
241 DiFioria (sic), his clan, moved me out of the City with the approval of some of this Council was  
242 here, like Mr. Brown, Mr. Reese and other Councilmen. They knew about the case, and they  
243 never investigated. They never did anything. I think what they doing to Ms. Woodson is very  
244 unfair and very, very, discrimination (sic).

245

246 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

247 Thank you. All right, do you have any other witnesses you want to call?

248

249 **NAKIA WOODSON**

250 No, Your Honor.

251

252 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

253 All right. Mr. DiFiore, this may very well end up in Court, so make the best record you can.

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254 **JIM DiFIORE**

255 Mayor, I'd like to present on the overhead, a fax cover that we received from Division of  
256 Insurance, just as late as yesterday, which shows that Ms. Woodson is still registered with the  
257 Division of Insurance for the State of Nevada at 1363 West Owens.

258

259 **NAKIA WOODSON**

260 Your Honor, I would like –

261

262 **JIM DiFIORE**

263 Again – this was part of my presentation where that was one of the reasons that she was denied,  
264 the fact that she didn't comply with NRS 697.280 which requires her to register with the  
265 Division of Insurance at the proper business location. 1363 West Owens was a denied use on  
266 August 6<sup>th</sup>. She never received a valid business license from that location, yet she still registers  
267 with the State of Nevada at that location.

268

269 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

270 All right. Ms. Woodson.

271

272 **NAKIA WOODSON**

273 Your Honor, I would dispute that document, and if necessary I would ask that this be continued  
274 to get the proper documentation from Division of Insurance. As stated, they charge a ten dollar  
275 fee for a change of address. My check has cleared. In addition, Mr. DiVorie (sic) is, of course,  
276 only presenting you Page 1 of a document that clearly states at the top, Page 1 of 3. Where're  
277 the rest of the papers?

278 I have a document here that clearly says, Branch address, 8-7-2-5 West Flamingo. So, if this is  
279 at issue, I would gladly, in a week, two-week, whatever time you guys will allow me to go to the  
280 Division of Insurance and get a letter confirming that. On file with them today is 3100 East Lake  
281 Mead, Number 20, as well as 8-7-2-5 West Flamingo. I dispute that. There's something not  
282 correct here. The forms are filled out and sent to Kim Coleman at the Division of Insurance.

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283 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

284 Well, all right. Well, it's gonna be up to Mayor Pro Tem, as to whether or not he wants to grant  
285 you a two-week continuance here.

286

287 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

288 Well, before we do that, I wanna hear about this letter that says, she keep, she kept referring to  
289 stating that she had a business license with the City of Las Vegas.

290

291 **JIM DiFIORE**

292 I –

293

294 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

295 That she paid all her fees and everything.

296

297 **JIM DiFIORE**

298 If I could have a few minutes to look at that letter, I'll be glad to comment on that.

299

300 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

301 Ms. Woodson is a very smart lady, so –

302

303 **ROLANDO LARRAZ**

304 I wouldn't give it to him. He would take it.

305

306 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

307 Wait.

308

309 **NAKIA WOODSON**

310 And if possible, Your Honors, I would ask that it's passed to each of the Councilmembers so they  
311 can read it for themselves. It clearly says that you're required to pay fees in advance. So, the

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312 fees that I paid to the City was for 1363 West Owens. I'm sure the Councilmen and  
313 Councilwoman can read it for themselves.

314

315 **JIM DiFIORE**

316 This letter is dated August 25<sup>th</sup>. It was at the –

317

318 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

319 Of what year?

320

321 **JIM Di FIORE**

322 Of – this year. Of 2008.

323

324 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

325 About a month ago.

326

327 **JIM DiFIORE**

328 Las Vegas Municipal Code requires each business to pay business license fees in advance.

329 When they come in to our front counter and they submit an application, those fees are taken for

330 them to either conduct business six months or one year in advance, based upon the classification.

331 In this particular case, Ms. Woodson had a valid business license at 1230 West Owens. Her

332 billing went out for that location. She paid the fees for that location. She did not file a business

333 license application for 1360 West Owens until, subsequent, until the billing had gone out. So,

334 her fees were actually being paid for on a 1203 West Owens location. Her business license,

335 again, for 1360 West Owens was never approved based upon Council's decision to deny the

336 Special Use Permit.

337

338 **NAKIA WOODSON**

339 Your Honor, again, I would appreciate if Council would read the letter for themselves. Mr.

340 DiForie (sic) is not being honest with you, here, today.

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341 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

342 Why don't you pass the letter up?

343

344 **NAKIA WOODSON**

345 It clearly states in the letter that I put in a change of address, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, to 1363 West Owens.

346 So, you're telling me from April 23<sup>rd</sup> to June they're still gonna send me a bill for 1363 West

347 Owens? That's not correct, Your Honor. Now he's asserting that it was for 1230 West Owens.

348 He says at the bottom of his letter, you put in a change of address April 23<sup>rd</sup>. He's correct.

349 Therefore, I got a bill two months later based upon 1363 West Owens. He's not being honest

350 with you, here, today.

351

352 **UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER**

353 Somebody (inaudible).

354

355 **NAKIA WOODSON**

356 You're right. It's, I have all my documentation here. He's not being straightforward.

357

358 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

359 Mr. Jerbic, do you wanna take a look at this?

360

361 **NAKIA WOODSON**

362 And here's the second page, Your Honor, if you need it. But if you clearly look at the bottom,

363 he's –

364

365 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

366 I – don't like, I want the whole document. If there're two pages, send them up. I don't like one

367 page out of three. That doesn't, there's a doctrine called the Completeness Doctrine and it would

368 not be admissible.

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369 **NAKIA WOODSON**

370 That's fine, Your Honor, but I would like to point everyone's attention to the two keys things I  
371 stated. That he stated that I had a license for 1363 West Owens. The fees were paid –

372

373 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

374 Right.

375

376 **NAKIA WOODSON**

377 – in advance.

378

379 **JIM DiFIORE**

380 No, I did not.

381

382 **NAKIA WOODSON**

383 In addition, at the bottom of his letter he states, you put in a change of address April 23<sup>rd</sup>. That's  
384 accurate. I put in the change of address April 23<sup>rd</sup>. I received a bill for 1363 West Owens in  
385 June and that bill was paid on June 30<sup>th</sup>.

386

387 **JIM DiFIORE**

388 Okay. Mayor, if – you don't mind, I'd like to respond to Ms. Woodson's comments. First of all,  
389 I've stated over, twice now, that she did not have a valid business license for 1360 West Owens.  
390 Again, her billing for the 1203 West Owens, during that time, went out. She had a valid business  
391 license at that location, but it became invalid when she moved to 1363 West Owens. She did not  
392 ever possess a business license for that location.

393 We're not here to argue that today. We're here to hear her argument about why she should not  
394 have a business license for the 8725 West Flamingo Road, as well as 3100 East Lake Mead.  
395 Both locations are outside of the City limits of Las Vegas. The grounds are clearly laid in your  
396 packet as to why my office denied her business license applications.

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397 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

398 Let me ask Mr. Jerbic this. What jurisdiction, sorry to catch you like this.

399

400 **BRAD JERBIC**

401 That's okay.

402

403 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

404 But what jurisdiction do we have over the County and over North Las Vegas that we can file  
405 with them?

406

407 **BRAD JERBIC**

408 We don't. We don't have any jurisdiction over their enforcement of their codes, just like they  
409 don't have any ability to influence us in the enforcement of our codes. But what Mr. DiFiore is  
410 saying that we – have many businesses that do business across jurisdictional lines. Locksmiths  
411 for example –

412

413 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

414 Right.

415

416 **BRAD JERBIC**

417 – will go from County to City to North Las Vegas to Henderson. In each jurisdiction you require  
418 a license in order to practice in that jurisdiction. And in this particular case, we have an  
419 applicant that has an application and a license in Clark County, also requires a license and  
420 application in the City and it has to meet our Code requirements. And that's what we're here on  
421 today. Regardless of the decision here today, the County will do what they wanna do, if they  
422 wanna do anything, and they may not. But in order for Ms. Woodson to do business in the City  
423 of Las Vegas, she requires a City business license.

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424 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

425 And what is doing business defined as?

426

427 **BRAD JERBIC**

428 Conducting any kind of business in the City of Las Vegas, receiving revenue, performing a  
429 service in the City; Mr. DiFiore can elaborate, but those are the two criteria that I, come to mind  
430 immediately.

431

432 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

433 All right, because right now she's barred from filing any bail bonds in the, in Muni Court.

434

435 **NAKIA WOODSON**

436 That's correct, Your Honor, pending the appeal.

437

438 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

439 Right. Pending the appeal.

440

441 **NAKIA WOODSON**

442 And can –

443

444 **BRAD JERBIC**

445 Not –

446

447 **NAKIA WOODSON**

448 – I state one other thing that I agree with Mr. DiFore (sic) just stated and our City Attorney  
449 correctly stated, I've met all the requirements of Clark County, all the requirements of North Las  
450 Vegas. So, as to, as Mr. DiFore (sic) clearly pointed out, probably that letter is irrelevant, but I  
451 just wanted it to be clear what I was sent by the City. And if the issue of my address as a DOI is  
452 at issue –

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453 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

454 Vicky. Vicky.

455

456 **NAKIA WOODSON**

457 – I'd be more than happy to bring you proof of that.

458

459 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

460 Fine. All right, I think we've heard both sides sufficiently. Mayor Pro Tem?

461

462 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

463 Well, again, this – is one of those items where I can certainly appreciate where staff's at on this,  
464 but she has legal business license in Clark County at this time, active.

465

466 **JIM DiFIORE**

467 She does. Now, and – my take on that would be, if she's posting bonds and sureties at the  
468 District Court or the Justice Court, County facilities, that she does not need a City business  
469 license to do that. But she does need a City business license to post these bonds and sureties at  
470 the City Detention Center, or at the Municipal Court window or at the Municipal Court  
471 courtrooms.

472

473 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

474 She's barred, so, I – really think, Mayor, for me the thing to do is just table this until after the  
475 hearing because she – can legally do business –

476

477 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

478 Right.

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479 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

480 – in the City of Las Vegas, as far as the Justice Center and District Court and – areas like that.  
481 Only she – only thing she needs permission from us to, I can't even talk, the permission from us  
482 today is to be able to work at Muni Court.

483

484 **JIM DiFIORE**

485 Muni Court, the City Detention Center where the bonds are posted.

486

487 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

488 I – read the judge's Order and until she gets her appeal

489

490 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

491 Yeah.

492

493 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

494 – if she's successful on her appeal, then she'll be able to address this issue. If she's not  
495 successful, she can't – do business with City entities.

496

497 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

498 Yeah. So, I – would move to table this until after the hearing.

499

500 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

501 All right. That's the motion. Let's vote. Post. Motion carries. **(Motion carried unanimously**  
502 **with WOLFSON not voting)** Thank you.
