**CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: December 03, 2008**

VINCENT YELDO, member of the Chaldean Catholic Church, responded that the facility is operated as a church regularly. Fundraiser events are held every other month for church members only. A member requested to hold a Holiday party at this facility and the New Year's Eve party is for church members only. He clarified that the hookah pipes are used by the members in the outside seating area. COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN stressed that the church not become a banquet facility and that these types of applications will be scrutinized carefully.
