PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On September 1, 2008, the Department of Health and Human Services-SAMHSA issued a Notice of Award to the city of Las Vegas EVOLVE program to administer a prisoner re-entry program. The purpose of this agreement is to allocate up to \$209,074 of Federal funds to Westcare Nevada for substance abuse/addiction treatment, relapse prevention and assessment services for EVOLVE program participants so they can attain sobriety, rehabilitation, self-sufficiency and stability as required by the Earmark Program.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Mayor and Council approve the agreement and authorizes the Director of Neighborhood Services to execute any and all related agreements/documents upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.
