PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Committee, a tax exempt organization, is requesting waiver of \$12,260.05 in city services in support of the 2009 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade. The parade is scheduled to take place Monday, January 19, 2009. The amount requested covers fees and labor for city provided services including street cleanup, crowd control barricades, show mobile rental fee, bleacher rental fees and event organization support. It is the Citys policy to support parades held on the Citys official downtown parade route that positively serve the Las Vegas community. In accordance with Ordinance #5567, the City Manager shall have the authority to grant waivers for city services up to \$7,500 per parade and \$37,500 for all parades during any one fiscal year.

RECOMMENDATION:

Consider the request by the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Parade Committee with a funding amount not to exceed \$12,260.05 to offset the cost of city provided services.
