**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The City's agreement with Republic Silver State Disposal, Inc. for waste collection services requires Republic to obtain the City's consent regarding transfers, assignments and other similar transactions, including the acquisition of the plurality of the voting control of Republic by another. A merger has been proposed between Republic Services parent company and Allied Waste Industries, Inc., a transaction requiring the City's consent.
