AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE THE COMPOSITION OF THE ARTS COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE CITY'S REPRESENTATION THEREON, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Sponsored by: Mayor Oscar B. Goodman Summary: Revises the composition of the City Arts Commission relative to the City's representation thereon.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 34, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 2.34.030:** The membership of the Arts Commission shall be as follows:
 - (A) Three members appointed by the Mayor;
 - (B) One member appointed by each of the City Councilmen;
 - (C) Two members appointed by the members who are appointed pursuant to Subsections (A) and (B) of this Section; and
 - (D) [The Director of Leisure Activities,] One member representative of City staff, appointed by the City Manager, or a designee, who shall serve ex officio.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.
