COUNCILMAN BROWN recognized AARON FOTHERINGHAM for setting a Guinness Book  
World Record for the first wheelchair backflip. COUNCILMAN BROWN described MR.  
FOTHERINGHAM as a remarkable young man who is a credit to himself and his family.

MR. FOTHERINGHAM thanked his family for their support and MAYOR GOODMAN  
presented him with a key to the City.

ADDITIONAL CEREMONIAL:

MAYOR GOODMAN recognized COUNCILMAN BROWN for all his accomplishments and  
who was attending his last City Council meeting. He stated that COUNCILMAN BROWN had  
won a seat on the Clark County Commission and would be joining them in January 2009.

MAYOR GOODMAN credited COUNCILMAN BROWN as the creator of the City's Parks
