David Fraser, Executive Director of the Nevada League of Cities, will update the Mayor and City Council on initiatives the League is currently engaged in. Additionally, he will discuss the Leagues 2009 State Legislative Package and issues that are anticipated at the upcoming legislative session.

DAVID FRASER, Executive Director of the Nevada League of Cities and Municipalities, and member of the National League of Cities Board of Directors, representing the West Coast as Region 8, gave a brief report. He stated the Nevada League would be presenting five bills at the upcoming Nevada legislative session on issues including redevelopment, city elections, and underground excavation.

Regarding the National League of Cities, MR. FRASER stated the National League was working to make cities direct recipients of the federal economic stimulus package. He noted that the National League had established a relationship with the Obama Transition Team and was looking forward to a great working relationship with the incoming administration.

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MR. FRASER stated that Assembly Bill 79 addressed city elections and had been requested by the City Clerk's Association to allow for mail-in ballots in certain situations and some other housekeeping items.
