Minutes:

CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY VAL STEED explained that the Code describes the boundaries of the Wards by precinct numbers and occasionally the Clark County Election Department changes those numbers. He stated the proposed First Amendment would add Precinct 2968 to Ward 5, the precinct number that was not included in the bill as introduced. He recommended Approval as a First Amendment.

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CITY CLERK BEVERLY BRIDGES informed COUNCILMAN BARLOW that the precinct added by the First Amendment referred to a small section of land that had been annexed into Ward 5. She explained it was an open parcel with no residents, but had its own precinct number because it could not be rolled into another precinct.
