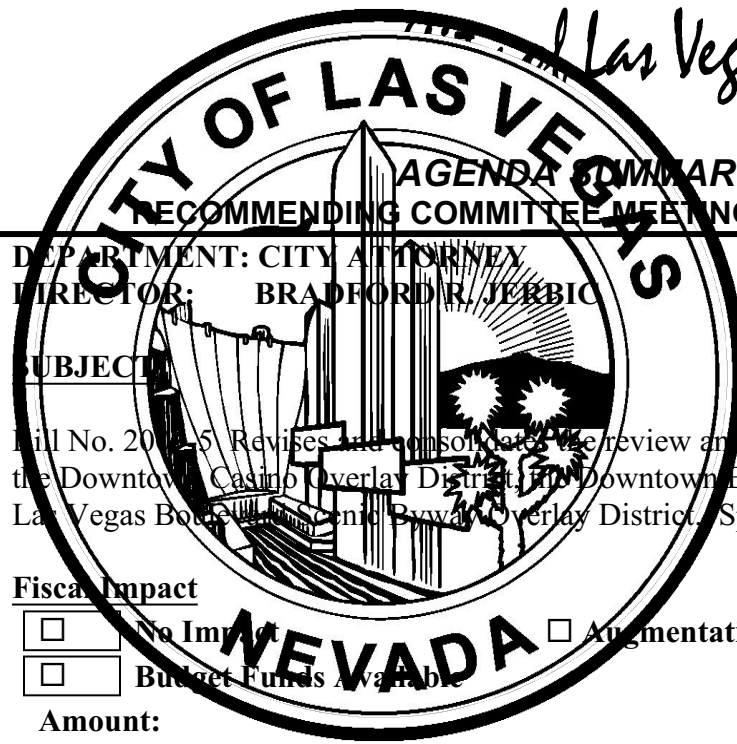

Minutes:

CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY VAL STEED stated that the initial version of this bill had contained a problematic component regarding building signage in the downtown area which had been removed in this version. He explained that this bill would ensure a single review process for the listed areas, thereby consolidating and simplifying the approval process. He pointed out this bill had already gone before the Planning Commission twice. He noted the item was in order and recommended approval.

CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY STEED clarified that the decisions made through this process would be final action unless appealed and pointed out the appeal process described in the bill.
