Minutes:

ANTHONY HODGES, Las Vegas resident, submitted a packet for CHAIRMAN GOODMAN and encouraged CHAIRMAN GOODMAN and MEMBER REESE to finish their terms and not return to public office.

After learning that Item 3 had been stricken from the agenda, JUANITA CLARK, Charleston Neighborhood Preservation, requested the names of the registered owners of the Redevelopment Agency (RDA) bonds for Item 4.

Regarding the Indenture of Trust Agreement for Item 4, DEE WISOR, Swensied & Stern, Bond Counsel for the City of Las Vegas, stated the parties to the bonds are the RDA and US Bank's Corporate Trust Department.

ACTING DEPUTY CITY MANAGER VINCENT also informed MS. CLARK that the RDA bonds are secured through revenues from the RDA.

TEDDY RUSSELL, Las Vegas resident, stated that the sale of the RDA bonds is good news for the City.

IVO PLITSCHKO stated that he had previously submitted a proposal to solve the homeless problem, submitted his contact information and suggested the City visit the Republic of Slovenia who had successfully dealt with their homeless situation.
