PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On November 17th, 2007 the City Council approved an Agreement that established the Las Vegas Valley Watershed Advisory Committee (LVVWAC) with the mission to protect, preserve and enhance water resources in the Las Vegas Valley and Lake Mead. The Regional Water Quality Plan represents a demonstrated effort among water and wastewater agencies in Southern Nevada to coordinate existing plans, policies and efforts related water resources of the Las Vegas Valley watershed and Lake Mead. The Plan identifies seven goals and associated strategies to help protect water quality and watershed resources. With the adoption of the Plan, LVVWAC will begin development of an Annual Operating Plan that details tactics to achieve operational and water quality goals to protect vital public, environmental and recreational resources.
