PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Historic Preservation Commission is comprised of members filling nine different categories. Terms are for four years, with no limit to the number of terms that may be served. Ms. Wright, Vice-Chair of the board represents the Category 6 member, Experienced in Nevada History; Ms. Hausch represents the Category 7 member, Citizen-At-Large (John S. Park Neighborhood Historic District.) Both individuals have served three terms and wish to be reappointed.
