DENNIS STONEY, Las Vegas resident, stated that the problem with building a new city hall is that it is being constructed solely for the purpose of putting people to work. His father did construction work for a living and he understood that it was seasonal work. MR. STONEY opposed building a new city hall and noted that COUNCILMAN ROSS should not vote on any construction matters while employed by the construction unions as secretary/treasurer. COUNCILMAN ROSS'S previous votes on union contracts have benefitted his employer by more than \$80 billion. Lastly, he stated that unlike many people, he does not believe that God's answer to all economic problems is to build more and create construction projects.
