PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City of Las Vegas anticipates utilizing \$226,273 of United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) ESG Funds for Fiscal Year 2009-2010. Neighborhood Services shall complete all HUD-required Environmental Reviews (ER). The CDRB (13 citizen appointments) reviewed applications and heard presentations in order to make funding recommendations to the City Council. No project may commit and/or expend any funds prior to compliance with 24 CFR Part 58 and final notification by Neighborhood Services. Should supplementary funds be granted to the City, additional allocations will be brought before Council for approval.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the ESG allocations and authorizes the Mayor to execute any and all related agreements and documents required for the projects following approval as to form by the City Attorney.
