I would like to introduce cutting edge technology to the community through commercial artwork. The artwork is LED technology and is interactive based on the time of day all the way to being based on people's feelings. One of the main features is how people can interact to the art through a wireless tablet. This interaction can change the color of the artwork with over 40 different color patterns and speeds. Along with the ways that light can travel through transparent colors to create endless color patterns.

- Detailed art work description, including status of the artwork: Is it completed, framed current location.

There will be extensive research of the content of the piece. The artwork will have a computer rendering for your approval with in three weeks of the approval of the concept. After approval of the art project, construction on the art will begin. The art installation is a mixed media project. The art piece is going to be built out of plexy glass that is layered 4 sheets deep that vary in sizes from 4'X3' to 4'X4' Sheets. A digital print layer will create a pattern and depth through the sheets. A Vegas theme will be set in place through digital prints through out the layers. The mounting system is recycled aluminum. There will be a removable decal stickers that will be places on the wall creating the mood for the project. The size is yet to be determined but can fill a whole wall, if permitted. The products that we use are of the utmost quality and sustainable and /or eco-friendly.

Biography of the Artist Aaron Shadab

Aaron Shadab is one of the best kept secrets of the art world, however the secret, transformed into the standard that defines a genre.

In his youth Aaron illustrated a profound love for art and this adoration. High school became a catalyst when his aptitude was combined with an exposure to a variety of new media. For his techniques with leaded glass, scratch board, and clay sculpture, Aaron was awarded Artist of The Year at SJMA High School as well as a scholarship to The University of Southern Colorado. It was there that Aaron quickly found his focus evolving from an interest in two dimensional works to three dimensional media. Working with cast iron pours and wood block print, his use and appreciation of negative space was developed.

Heavily influenced by the electronic music culture that was exploding in the underground scene of the early 90s, Aaron found an affinity for the multicultural and multimedia aspects that defined the movement. The construct of his beliefs about how art represented life evolved again in a direction that defied pencil and paper and moved more into an experience that could only be realized by the sense of sight. He now saw that three dimensional art was only the beginning of what he would one day give back to the community that inspired him.

In 2000 Aaron sought to find new outlets for his ideas in the form of practical applications. To diversify his exposure, Aaron joined with Gensler, high profile interior design firm in Chicago, to develop custom high end wall finishes. Continuing with his goal of making his artwork something that could be moved through rather than just looked at, entire rooms became his canvas. After winning an award for the most innovative wall finishes at Global Shop in 2001, his reputation for innovation, he was commissioned for such as projects at the Hotel Intercontinental in Chicago, VBH Luxury in New York and the Aria City Center in Las Vegas, the hottest new hotel casino on The Strip.

Currently Aaron's continues to run parallel with emerging technologies and to redefine the cutting edge techniques he's developed in practical application with that of his more abstract three dimensional work. The size and scope of his works are no longer limited to something that could be framed and hung on a wall but with the use of thousands of different products and ideas Aaron Shadab is building multimedia microcosms for people to explore.
