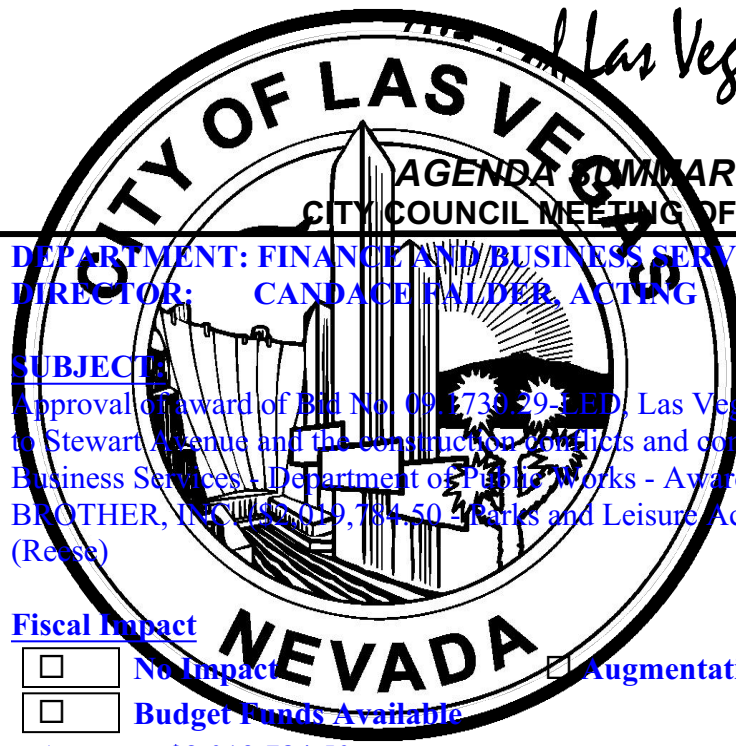

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This project consists of constructing an intermodel trail system in the Las Vegas Wash Corridor from Owens Avenue to Stewart Avenue. It is a shared, multi-use facility for non-motorized traffic including bicycles, pedestrians and skaters. Rest areas are provided with benches, trees, fitness equipment, drinking fountains, bags for dog waste and trash receptacles. Lighting will be installed along portions of the trail. The Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act is providing 94% of the funding for this project and Question 1 Grant from the State of Nevada, Division of State Lands is providing 6%.
