Motion made by RICKI Y. BARLOW to Approve subject to the following conditions as read for the record:

A. Hours of operation shall be 7 a.m. to 10 p.m., Sunday through Thursday, and from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Friday and Saturday.

B. The licensee must provide highly visibly, uniformed, unarmed security personnel who must obtain and be in possession of a valid work card during employment. Security shall address parking lot issues during the hours of 2 p.m. to closing.

C. The licensee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system to aid in monitoring activity inside and outside the store.

D. The licensee shall post signs inside and outside the store which notify patrons of the video surveillance system.

E. The licensee shall work with Metro and security to enforce trespassing of undesirables.

F. The licensee shall enforce no loitering and no alcohol consumption within 1000 feet.

Minutes:

JIM DiFIORE, Business Services Manager, noted the calls for service report by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (Metro) had been provided to the Council and discussed with the applicants. The 17 calls for service not generated by Metro during this six-month period were consistent with the number of calls during the previous review period. Most of the calls were related to trespassing issues and addressed by both the licensees and Metro. The applicant had attended the Metro First Tuesday meetings and had a good working relationship with the Bolden Area Command.

SOLAR SHOSHANI and THASER JARJEES, the licensees, were present. MR. JARJEES stated that they were working with Metro and the City to improve the area. MR. SHOSHANI thanked Metro and the City for working with them.

MR. DiFIORE recommended approval of the license subject to conditions without any future review, noting he would bring the license before the Council if any areas of concern develop. The business had been inspected several times and was found to be in compliance with all business licensing conditions and standards.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW thanked MR. SHOSHANI and MR. JARJEES for their efforts to improve the area and commended them for working with Metro. He also encouraged them to sweep the property more frequently.
