**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

In accordance with NRS 548.283 (1), the governing bodies of the incorporated cities within Clark County may appoint one representative to serve as supervisor on the Conservation District of Southern Nevada (CDSN) Board. Mr. Dirick Van Gorp has resigned from this position effective September 2008 after serving almost five terms. The CDSN is recommending the appointment of Mr. Chris Magee, Environmental Manager in the Energy and Environmental Services Division of the MGM Mirage. To date, the Henderson, North Las Vegas and Mesquite Councils have considered and unanimously voted to appoint Mr. Magee to this position. The Las Vegas City and Boulder City Council votes are now required for this appointment to be confirmed. Each supervisor shall serve for a term of two years.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Options are: The Las Vegas City Council approve Mr. Chris Magee to serve on the Conservation District of Southern Nevada Board OR place another name in nomination for service on this Board for consideration by other local agencies.
