4 AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY
5 BUSINESS LICENSES FOR PRIVILEGED BUSINESSES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER
RELATED MATTERS.

6 Sponsored by: Councilman Steve Wolfson Summary: Authorizes the administrative
7 issuance of temporary business licenses for
privileged businesses.

8 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
9 AS FOLLOWS:

10 SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 6, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
11 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **6.06.010:** (A) The provisions of this Chapter apply to those businesses which are found by
13 the City Council to require a high degree of supervision and to more seriously affect the economic,
14 social and moral well-being of the City and its residents. These businesses have been commonly
15 referred to as "privileged" and require City Council approval for a license[.] , except for the license
16 categories described in Paragraph (1) of Subsection (B).

17 (B) For purposes of this Chapter, the term "license approval authority" means:

18 (1) The Director, for licenses issued under the provisions of Chapters 6.47,
19 6.55 and 6.69; and

20 (2) The City Council, for all other categories.

21 SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 6, Section 51, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
22 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 **6.06.051:** (A) At the request of an applicant, the [City Council or, as authorized by Subsection
24 (C), the] Director may grant a temporary license, effective for a period not to exceed ninety days,
25 pending [the Council's decision] final action regarding a license application in order for the license
26 approval authority to determine:

27 (1) The applicant's fitness for a license; and

28 (2) The appropriateness of the applicant's business location.

- 1 (B) A temporary license shall not be granted under this Section unless:
- 2 (1) All principals required to be approved for suitability have submitted a
- 3 complete investigation packet for determination of suitability and paid all applicable fees;
- 4 (2) The Director makes a preliminary finding that all of the principals of
- 5 the business are suitable; and
- 6 (3) The applicant has submitted a completed and accurate license
- 7 application and has paid all required application fees.

8 [(C) The Director shall have the authority to issue temporary licenses under this

9 Section for business licenses within the following categories:

- 10 (1) Ice cream truck;
- 11 (2) Mobile food vendor; and
- 12 (3) Reflexology.]

13 SECTION 3: Title 6, Chapter 6, Section 52, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las

14 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 **6.06.052:** (A) Prior to the expiration of a temporary license issued under LVMC 6.06.051, [A]

16 the temporary license may be [issued initially by the City Council for a] extended by the license

17 approval authority for an initial extension period of not to exceed six months.

18 (B) The [City Council] license approval authority may grant one additional

19 extension of a temporary license for a period not to exceed six months.

20 (C) When granting a temporary license or extension thereof, the [City Council]

21 license approval authority may impose any special conditions and restrictions [it deems] deemed

22 appropriate.

23 SECTION 4: Title 6, Chapter 6, Section 53, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las

24 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 **6.06.053:** During a temporary licensing period the applicant shall comply with any requirement

26 imposed by this Code, or other local, State or Federal law or regulation and any special conditions and

27 restrictions imposed by the [City Council.] license approval authority.

28 SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 2009.

1 SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
2 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
3 ~~ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or~~
4 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
5 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
6 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
7 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
8 invalid or ineffective.

9 SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
10 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
11 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
