Minutes:

MARGO WHEELER, Director of Planning and Development, stated that Items 68-73 were requested to be tabled by the applicant, who has six months to bring them back for consideration or the applications will expire. ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY SCOTT pointed out that any significant changes to the project in the interim would have to be reviewed by the Planning Commission first. He explained for COUNCILMAN WOLFSON that significant changes would be any amendment to the site plan that might affect elevations, setback reductions, etc. MS.
