COUNCILMAN ROSS invited CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONER LARRY BROWN to the podium to recognize the Centennial High School Girls 4A Soccer Team. COUNCILMAN ROSS congratulated the team on successfully defending their title and winning the State Championship on March 11, 2009. He noted that Centennial High School has won the State Championship four times, more than any other team in the State. He introduced each member of the team and stated their dedication and commitment make them a huge asset to the community.

COUNCILMAN ROSS invited EMMANUEL AYIM, Head Coach, and AMANDA THOMAS, Assistant Coach, to the dias and presented COACH AYIM with certificates for the team. COACH AYIM thanked COUNCILMAN ROSS, MAYOR GOODMAN and the Council for the recognition. He also thanked the Centennial High School administration for their support. The team had a phenomenal season and accomplished their goal of defending their title.
