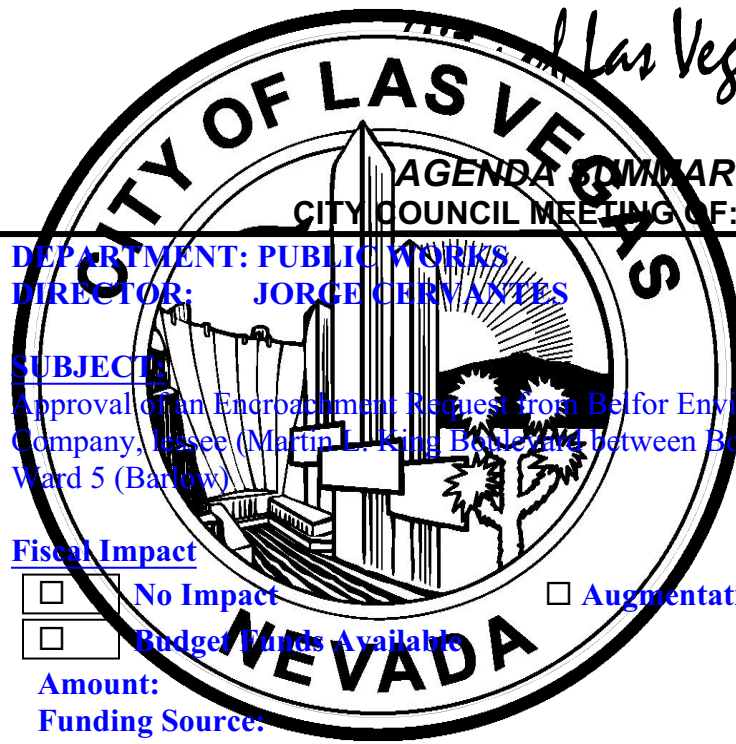

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This request consists of a 2-inch polyvinylchloride (PVC) pipe located on the east side of Martin L. King Boulevard approximately 4-feet below the surface of the roadway approximately 9-feet from the back of curb beginning approximately 153-feet north of Bonanza Road extending northward for approximately 553-feet to McWilliams Avenue where it will connect to a storm drain system. The pipe will be used to remove treated discharge water as part of a remediation system for the former Conoco Gas Station No.28003. If approved, the applicant will be required to sign an Encroachment Agreement that has conditions of maintenance, liability and removal.
