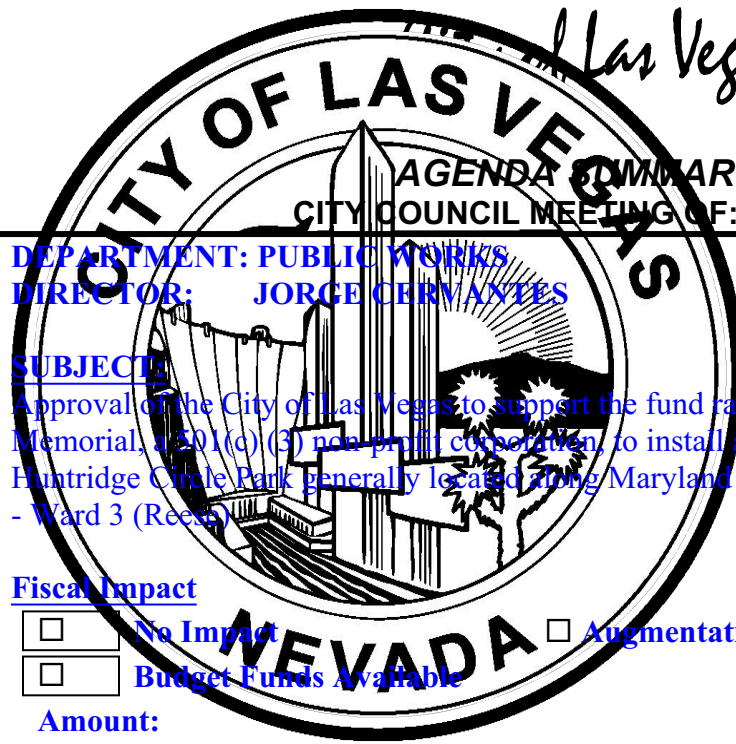

It is proposed that a Veteran's Memorial Monument will be constructed and installed at the Huntridge Circle Park at no cost to the City. Las Vegas Veteran's Memorial Corporation will fund and prepare design plans and construction of the memorial. The estimated amount of the monument is approximately \$800,000. It is agreed that any excess funds raised shall be used for supplemental improvements to the Huntridge Circle Park.
