Minutes:

CAROL MEYER, Supervisor of Business Services, stated that IRMA FRAGOSA had been approved for a temporary tavern license and also applied for gaming license which would be heard by the Nevada Gaming Commission on April 16, 2009. The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (Metro) had reported only six calls for service at this location, resulting in one arrest for trespassing and one for domestic violence. The low number of calls for service reflects MS. FRAGOSA'S hard work and MS. MEYER recommended approval of the permanent license for the tavern. She also recommended approval of the gaming license, subject to approval by the Nevada Gaming Commission.

MS. FRAGOSA stated she is on the premises and closely managing the bar. She assured the Council that if her license is approved, she would maintain that level of involvement.
