Minutes:

JIM DiFIORE, Business Services Manager, stated that REGINA EDWARDS had received approval for a temporary supper club license in April 2008 which had been extended with a review scheduled for this meeting. The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department report had raised concerns regarding financial problems in MS. EDWARDS work history. MS. EDWARDS contacted staff in December 2008 and requested that the license be placed on inactive status. Subsequently, staff learned that MS. EDWARDS filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy

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in January 2009. MS. EDWARDS had requested permanent approval of her license, but staff has had no recent contact with her. MR. DiFIORE recommended that the City Council take no action, allowing the temporary license to expire. When the license expires, it would not become an asset in MS. EDWARDS bankruptcy case. He noted that the Council could choose to deny the license, preventing MS. EDWARDS from applying for any privileged license with the City for one year.

JENNIFER SANDERS appeared on behalf of US TRUSTEE JAMES LISOWSKI who is handling MS. EDWARDS' bankruptcy. Her duty was to protect any assets of the estate, noting that if the license is approved, it becomes an asset which can be used to pay creditors.

MAYOR PRO TEM REESE recognized MS. SANDERS' position but stated he could not support approval of this license without knowing what might happen to it.
