Respectfully we request that key points be added, in a manner which would be meaningful for the general population, to the current 3 terse lines provided on the agenda.

*#28—We request that this item be REMOVED from this days agenda because we find the files on line are not available which is becoming "rather common". We request that a check of this concern be made and rectified.

#30—Please state the "Large Diameter" size in inches/feet for this nearly \$million expenditure.
