PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City of Las Vegas received a request for speed humps on 20th Street between Bonanza Road and Harris Avenue. Studies conducted on 20th Street showed that the 85th percentile speed was 30 mph and the volume of traffic was 894 vehicles per day. The street accumulated 39 points; a total of 40 points is needed to meet the criteria for speed humps. It is a secondary emergency response route.
