ATTORNEY TABITHA FIDDYMENT, 3800 Howard Hughes Parkway, appearing on behalf of the applicants, requested Items 97-100 be tabled and that Item 96 be pulled from the One Motion/One Vote calendar for discussion.

Regarding Item 127, TIM AYALA, 4600 Sunset Road, representing the applicant, asked the Council to consider the amount of people in the audience in support of Item 127. By a show of hands, MAYOR GOODMAN counted about 15 people in support and 10 in opposition.
