Minutes:

CAROL MEYER, Supervisor of Business Services, stated the applicant has met the criteria for temporary approval of this license. She recommended approval subject to conditions, including those she read for the record.

COUNCILMAN REESE expressed concern that more than one massage therapist will be working for the business. MS. MEYER explained that the Code only permitted one room for the accessory massage use, but did not address scheduling or the number of therapists that could be hired. Also, the massage use would only be permitted during the office's normal business hours.

DR. TERRY AKERS, 2931 North Tenaya Way, was present and stated he has been in business for 13 years. He explained that the establishment of the Massage Board required all chiropractors and massage therapists who work in chiropractic offices obtain City business licensing.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW stated that DR. AKERS has a great reputation and is committed to the community.
