The 2010 Census: How Does Nevada Benefit?

- ▶ Power
 - ▶ Representation in Congress
 - ▶ Electoral Votes
 - ▶ Redistricting of State Legislature
- ▶ Jobs
 - ▶ Approximately 4,000 Nevadans To Be Hired Altogether in 2010
 - ▶ 1,340 Nevadans Already Hired for Address Canvassing Operation

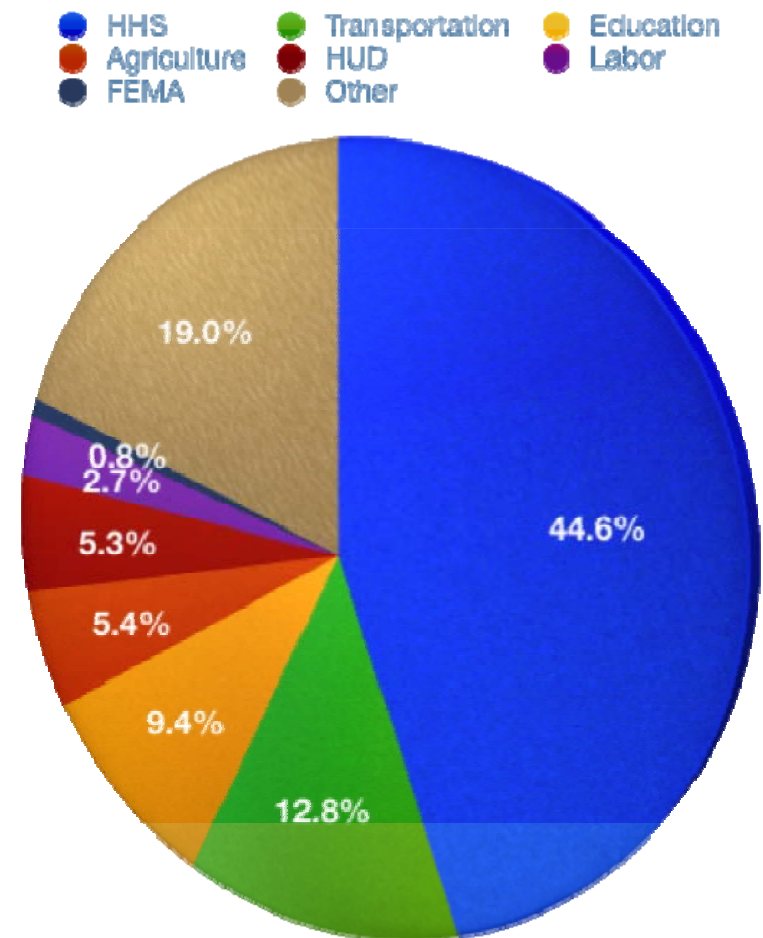


The 2010 Census: How Does Nevada Benefit?

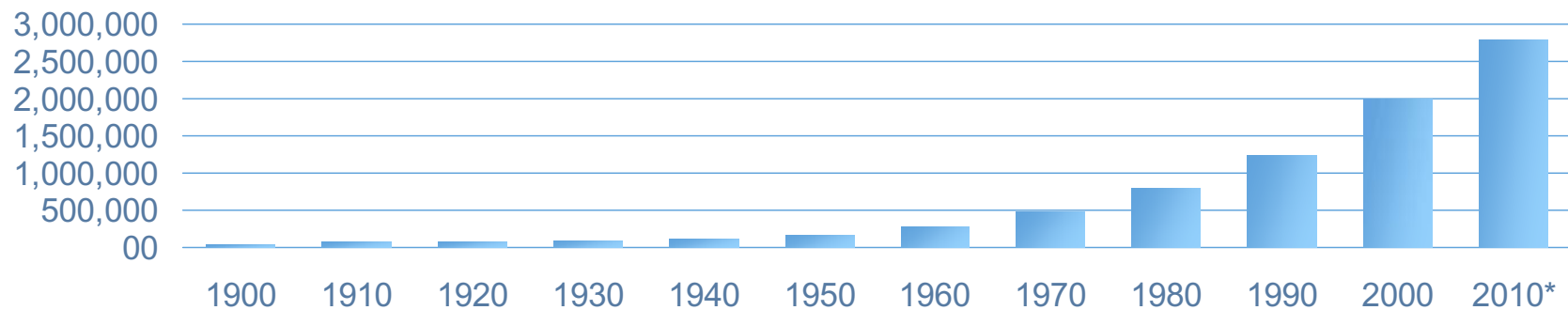
► Money

- Every Nevadan Missed by the Census Bureau in 2010 Translates to \$917 Per Person Per Year

A Tale of Two Censuses



• Nevada's 1990 Census

- ▶ Limited Partnership Activities
- ▶ A Reliance on National Messaging with Little Nevada Resonance or Imagery
- ▶ Nevada: The Fifth-Worst Census Mailed Response Rate in the Nation
- ▶ A 2.30% Undercount in Nevada

Nevada's 2000 Census

- ▶ Significant Partnerships Throughout Nevada With Community and Governmental Groups
- ▶ Nevada-Specific Marketing and Messaging
- ▶ Nevada: The Best Improvement in Census Response of Any Station in the Nation
- ▶ A 1.68% Undercount in Nevada

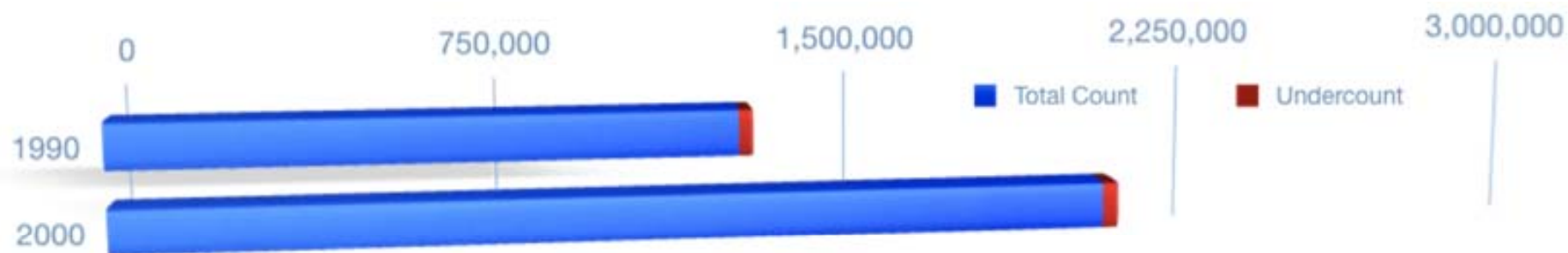

A Successful Approach for Nevada

- ▶ Answer the Question: “What’s In It For Me?”
- ▶ Use Nevada Leaders, Nevada Imagery, and Respect Skepticism
- ▶ Recast Nevada’s Census Effort as a Grassroots Neighborhood Campaign



Doing the Math: The Impact of the Undercount



- **Nevada's 1990 Census**

- **Total Population: 1,236,130**

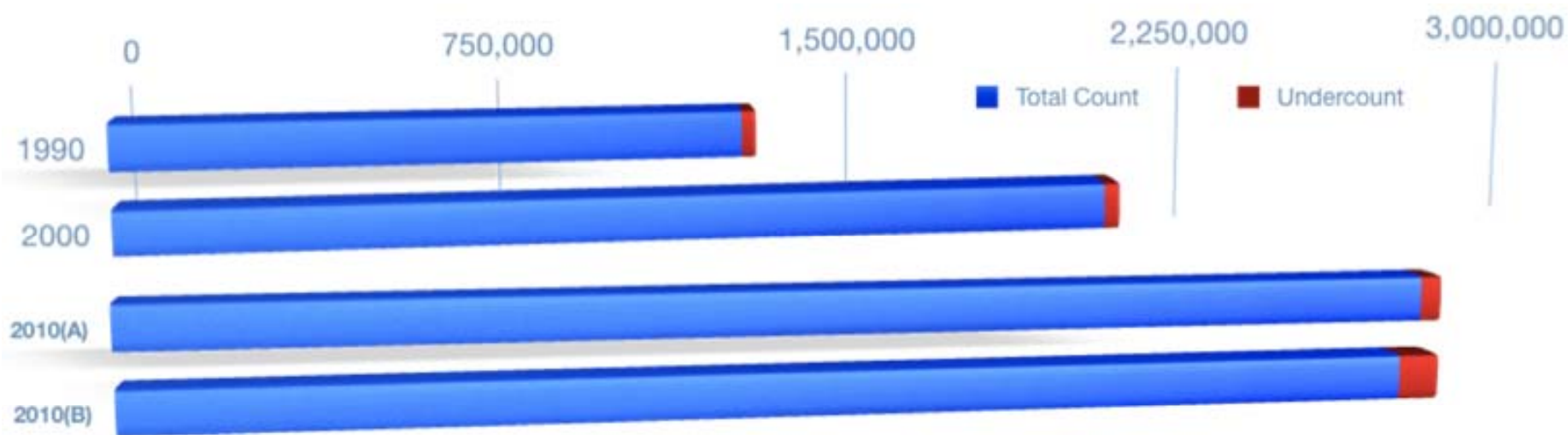
- **Undercount: 2.30% =
28,431 Nevadans Missed**

- **Nevada's 2000 Census**

- **Total Population: 1,998,257**

- **Undercount: 1.68% =
33,570 Nevadans Missed**

Doing the Math: The Impact of the Undercount



- **2010 Census: Scenario A**

- **Estimated Population: 2,801,551**

- **Undercount: 1.68%**
47,066 Nevadans Missed

- **Impact: \$43.2 Million Annually**

- **2010 Census: Scenario B**

- **Estimated Population: 2,801,551**

- **Undercount: 2.30%**
64,436 Nevadans Missed

- **Impact: \$59.1 Million Annually**
