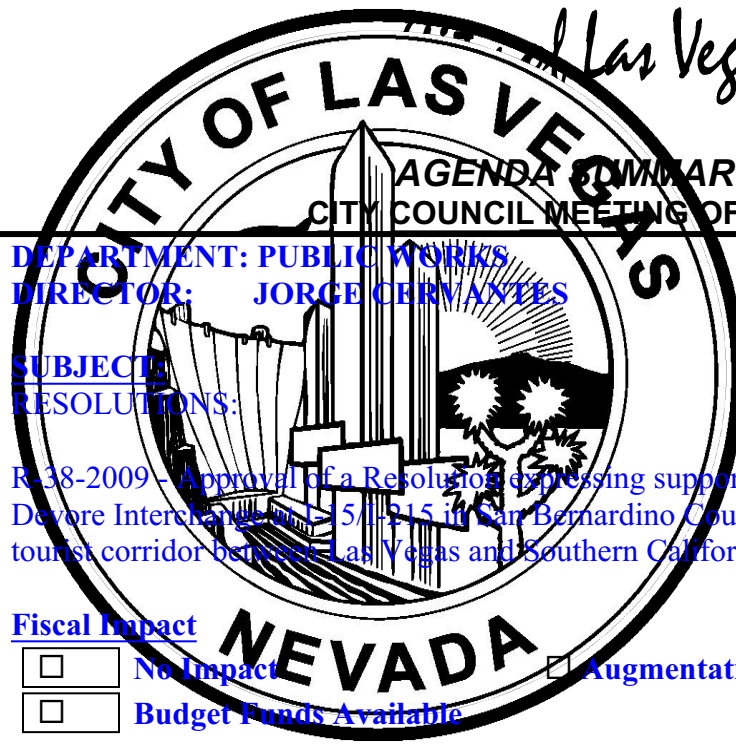

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Interstate 15 (I-15) is the economic lifeline for much of the Western United States including California and Nevada. It serves as a major tourist corridor for visitors coming to Las Vegas. I-15 is also a major corridor for commercial goods shipped by truck from the Long Beach ports and has been designated as a "Trade Corridor of National Significance". I-215 works in concert with Interstate 15 as an additional national trade connection and has relied on Federal, State and local funding sources for major improvements. The economies of Southern Nevada and Southern California will greatly benefit from the construction of a new interchange in Devore.
