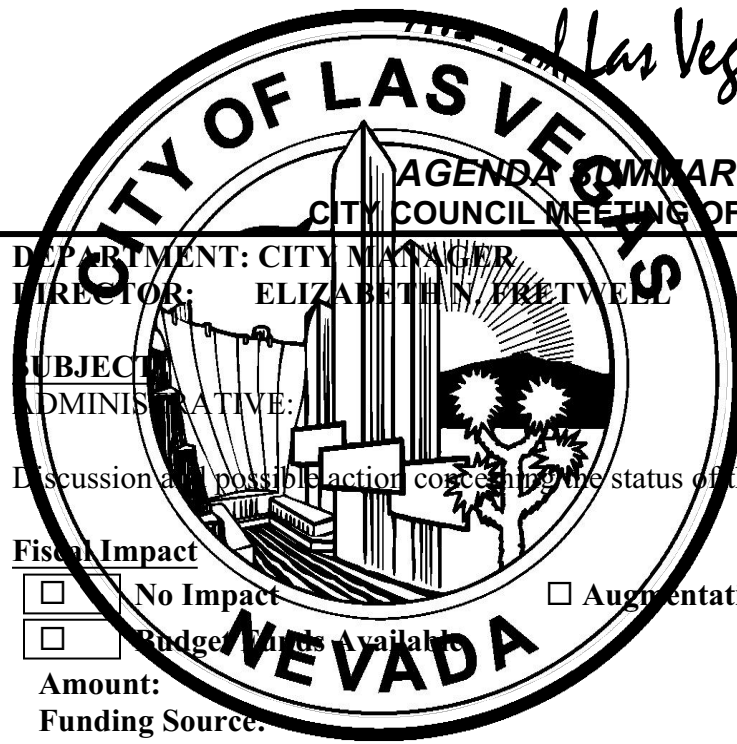

Minutes:

CITY MANAGER ELIZABETH FRETWELL indicated that the Nevada State Legislature wrapped up all its businesses for this session on Monday at midnight. Staff is currently compiling a complete report on the Bills that impact the City of Las Vegas and will be briefing the Council to describe those various impacts. The City fared well, as this was a very difficult session for everyone. The City legislative team did an excellent job, working very hard and very long hours. Many of the matters that came forward that would have had significant impacts on the City's ability to provide services to the community were modified in an acceptable way. She preferred not to go into detail, pending the comprehensive report at the next City Council meeting. This would allow time to assess the impact of the Governor's final actions.

COUNCILMAN WOLFSON asked that the briefings include a list of the legislators seats up for election and how many are in the City of Las Vegas.
