PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Under current ordinances and regulations, alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the parking lots and playground areas of City parks, but there has been some uncertainty as to how to apply the prohibitions in various locations. Additionally, park-related problems caused by the presence of alcoholic beverages and glass containers have increased, calling for a broadening of the existing prohibition. This bill will provide an updated rule, prohibiting alcoholic beverages and glass beverage containers in City parks except pursuant to a permit or other written authorization.
