DAVID ROGER, Clark County District Attorney, expressed his gratitude to MAYOR GOODMAN, the City Council members, CITY MANAGER ELIZABETH FRETWELL, DEPUTY CITY MANAGER ORLANDO SANCHEZ and BECKY SPRAY, Administrative Services Office, for their assistance in obtaining federal funding for a vice prosecutor for Clark County.
