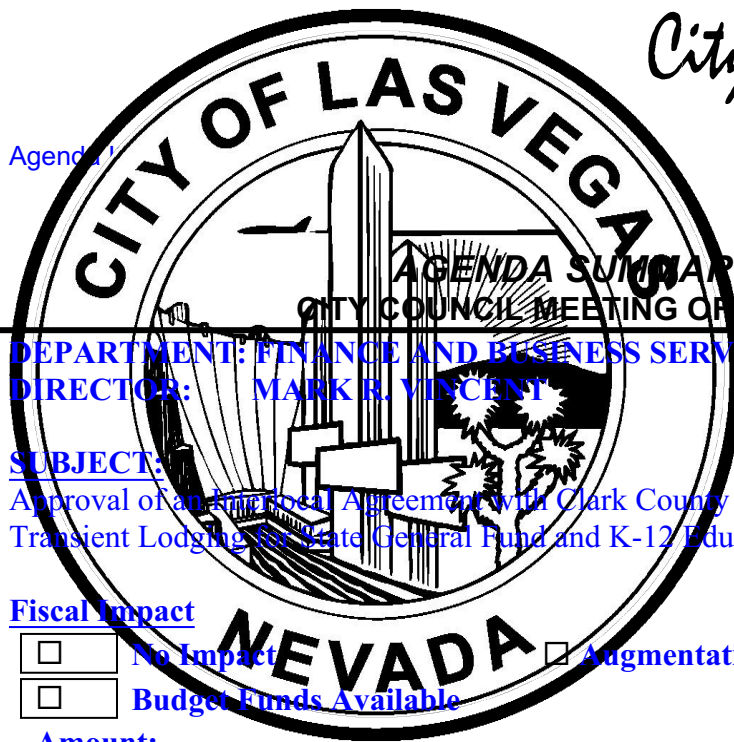

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Initiative Petition 1 became effective during the 2009 Legislative Session, reflecting the desire of the voters to increase the transient lodging tax to help fund State programs and K-12 education. In order to implement the terms of the petition, Clark County has adopted an ordinance to impose the tax, which applies to transient lodging in both incorporated and unincorporated areas of the County. Within its jurisdiction, the City will collect the tax from lodging establishments and remit to the County the amounts so collected. The Interlocal Agreement sets forth the terms of this cooperative arrangement.
