Westside School

1923

The first school in West Las Vegas opened with two rooms and two teachers for four grades.

From 1904 until 1923, children from McWilliams' Townsite crossed the railroad tracks to get to school in Clark's Townsite. This dangerous situation lasted until the Las Vegas School District built this two-room school on land in the new Valley View addition, adjoining McWilliam's Townsite on the east.

The school quickly expanded with two more rooms in 1928 when news of the construction of Hoover Dam brought families from the south searching for work. A kindergarten was added 1938, and in 1942 a small building from the Civilian Conservation Corps camp was moved to the site to house third and fourth grades. Fifth grade was added in 1947. Finally, in 1948, a concrete block addition with eight classrooms was built next to the original school building to house sixth, seventh and eighth grades. In May 1949, twenty-seven students graduated in the first eighth grade commencement class.

New neighborhoods and schools to serve them came quickly in the 1950s The Westside School, was phased out for school use in 1967, and became city property in 1974. Shortly thereafter, the city leased the building to the Economic Opportunity Board (EOB) as a community center and radio station.

ITEM 1: OPEN MEETING LAW/CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 12:15 p.m. by Chairperson Bob Stoldal. Frank Fiori noted the meeting had been properly noticed in accordance with the Open Meeting Law.

As a matter of business, Frank Fiori announced that Iyeka Coleman has resigned from the City to pursue other interests and Kathy McDonald would be replacing her in the Comprehensive Planning division and taking over her duties.

ITEM 2: APPROVAL OF THE AUGUST 22, 2001 MEETING MINUTES

Colleen Beck made a motion for approval of the August 22, 2001 meeting minutes; Cathie Kelly seconded the motion – Unanimous approval.

ITEM 3: DISCUSS NOMINATION TO THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES FOR THE MORELLI HOUSE, WHICH IS BEING MOVED FROM DESERT INN ESTATES TO 814 BRIDGER STREET; TAKE ANY APPROPRIATE ACTION.

Frank Fiori stated that this item was carried forward from the August 22, 2001 meeting in which The Commission acted in support of the State placing the Morelli House on the State Register of Historic Places. There was discussion about the placing the Morelli House on the City Register of Historic Places. Bob Stoldal opened this item to discussion.

Frank Fiori clarified that there is a procedure in place in the Zoning Ordinance (19A06.5) for designating landmarks, historic properties and historic districts. It takes you through the process of going through the Historic Preservation Commission, Planning Commission and City Council. Frank stated there is a need to create a form or application and for the commission to identify and prioritize which properties would be eligible and what order to process them in.

The Commission members discussed the status of the Morelli House. Mary Hausch made a motion to table any action on the Morelli House until the October meeting when it would be within the City limits.

Cathie Kelly made a motion to amend the motion to table any action on the Morelli House decision until such time as a formal application is prepared and a process is in place. Dorothy seconded the motion. – Unanimous approval.

Bob Stoldal asked staff to prepare an application form for the commission to review at the next meeting, along with a contact list of eligible properties to add to the City Register. Bob also asked staff to prepare a draft letter to send to the property owners.

ITEM 4: DISCUSS A LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR THE PROPOSED REUSE OF THE OLD FEDERAL BUILDING/POST OFFICE; TAKE ANY APPROPRIATE ACTION.

Commission members reviewed a draft of a proposed resolution in support of the reuse of the old Federal Building/Post Office. Bob Stoldal acknowledged there has been a suggested change in the second to the last paragraph. Cathie Kelly made a motion to approve as amended “to incorporate the Federal Building/Post Office into the proposed redevelopment of the site into a park”. Dorothy Wright seconded the motion – Unanimous approval.

ITEM 5: DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED PROJECT FOR 2002 CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT; TAKE ANY APPROPRIATE ACTION.

A subcommittee consisting of Bob Stoldal, Janet White and Frank Wright was appointed.

Ideas for grant applications from Southern Nevada:

- Railroad Cottages
- Historic survey areas within the City
- Development of a Historic Las Vegas photo bibliography (archive)
- Development of a feasibility study for West Las Vegas

The grant application is due to the City by November 2, 2001. Bob Stoldal asked Frank Fiori to make copies of the grant forms for the subcommittee. Bob Stoldal noted that the subcommittee will submit their recommendations at the October, 2001 meeting along with the completed grant forms.

ITEM 6: GENERAL DISCUSSION ON THE STATUS OF THE RAILROAD COTTAGES LOCATED IN THE 600 BLOCK OF CASINO CENTER BOULEVARD.

Bob Stoldal noted that he was not able to set up a tour of the Railroad Cottages, but the County is moving forward with their application to the Commission on Cultural Affairs, which is due by October 1, 2001.

Dorothy Wright spoke to the County regarding their grant application to move one of the cottages to the County Heritage Museum to be refurbished. One suggestion was made to have the City pay rent to the owner to relocate one of the cottages now and begin refurbishing it.

ITEM 7: RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON THE STATUS OF THE JOHN S. PARK NEIGHBORHOOD HISTORIC DESIGNATION EFFORT

Yorgo Kagafas stated that the Historic John S. Park Neighborhood Plan has been submitted to the City and is scheduled for the October 18, 2001, Planning Commission meeting for an informational hearing, then scheduled for the November 1, 2001 Planning Commission meeting for a vote, then onto the City Council on December 19, 2001 for approval. If adopted, then the next step is to obtain Historic District Designation.

ITEM 8: RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON THE STATUS OF GRANTS RECEIVED AND APPLIED FOR.

Frank Fiori noted we are awaiting the contract from the state to put this item on the City Council agenda. Once approved, then we can move forward to enter into a contract with a consultant.

ITEM 1: OPEN MEETING LAW/CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 12:15 p.m. by Chairperson Bob Stoldal. Frank Fiori noted the meeting had been properly noticed in accordance with the Open Meeting Law.

ITEM 2: APPROVAL OF THE SEPTEMBER 26, 2001 MEETING MINUTES

Cathie Kelly made a motion for approval of the September 26, 2001 meeting minutes; Mary Hausch seconded the motion – Unanimous approval.

ITEM 3: DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED PROJECTS FOR 2002 CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT; TAKE ANY APPROPRIATE ACTION.

A subcommittee consisting of Bob Stoldal, Frank Wright and Janet White was formed to discuss proposed projects for 2002 local government grant. Bob Stoldal reported that Janet White had been unable to attend the subcommittee meeting due to illness. Bob Stoldal and Frank Wright outlined a list of the areas needing a survey update, the last survey occurring in 1984. The list

included John S Park, Central Las Vegas, Clark Townsite, Biltmore, the west side (bounded by Bonanza Road on the south, Owens on north, Rancho on the west and Main Street on the east, and the Huntridge area (Vegas Verdes).

The existing grant for 2001 included the John S Park area, the central part of Las Vegas part 1 including elements in Clark Townsite. The new grant for 2002 will be used to finish Central Las Vegas, Clark Townsite and the contiguous additions, a west side intensive survey, similar to John S Park, and Biltmore II. The costs will include printing as well as the survey and funds to write nominations for the Historic Register. Nominations would include the Bonanza underpass, the Charleston House, the Christensen House, the Binion house and the Westside School, all of which are within the west side area. The grant application for 2002 deadline is December 1, 2001.

Dorothy Wright made a motion for Frank Fiori to complete and submit the grant application for the City Grant Committee due November 2, 2001, and to complete and submit the State Grant Application due December 1, 2001. Cathie Kelly seconded the motion – Unanimous approval.

ITEM 4: DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED APPLICATION FORMS FOR HISTORIC DESIGNATIONS AND DIRECT STAFF ACCORDINGLY

Sean Robertson created a one-page “Application for Historic Designation” for the committee’s approval. Frank Fiori explained the application details and the committee suggested the following changes and/or clarification:

1. Change Title to “City of Las Vegas Application for Historic Designation”
2. Change Name to Property Name
3. Type of Property, change Archaeological Site to Site, change Landmark to Structure
4. Under Submittal checklist, add Photographs
5. Under Property owner consent, add “Letter of Consent attached” to be used in the event a property is being recommended that is owned by someone else

ITEM 5: REVIEW AND DISCUSSION OF THE LIST OF NATIONAL REGISTER PROPERTIES THAT ARE NOT ALSO LISTED ON THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS HISTORIC REGISTER

Staff put together the list of properties that are not also listed on the City of Las Vegas Historic Register as follows:

Bob Stoldal instructed staff to begin the process to add the following properties to the City of Las Vegas Historic Register:

The first step would be to draft a letter to property owners asking them if they are interested and would consent to having their property listed on the City's register. A draft of the proposed letter will be brought to the next HPC meeting.

Bob Stoldal asked staff to provide a list of the State Historic Register and National Historic Register properties in the Commission's ringbinders.

Bob Stoldal instructed staff to send a letter to Jerry Kaufman with information on historic designation that acknowledges the protection and additional elements that go with this process, and include a copy of the ordinance along with an application. Bob Stoldal instructed Frank Fiori to give the committee an update at the next meeting.

**ITEM 6: GENERAL DISCUSSION ON THE STATUS OF THE RAILROAD
COTTAGES LOCATED IN THE 600 BLOCK OF CASINO CENTER BOULEVARD**

The railroad cottage on 3rd Street has been sold to the neighboring law firm, who plans to use this property for a parking lot. Dorothy Wright has been working on moving the cottage within the 60 day timeframe given by the new owners. Bob Stoldal stated that there are some state funds available and Dorothy is getting estimates to move the cottage to the County Museum. The County has a request before the Cultural Affairs Commission for funds to restore it.

Richann Johnson had stated in the past that there is a possibility the City may be interested in moving one of the cottages over by the Post Office.

**ITEM 7: RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON THE STATUS OF THE JOHN S. PARK
NEIGHBORHOOD HISTORIC DESIGNATION EFFORT**

Bob Bellis stated the John S. Park Plan went before the Planning Commission on October 18, 2001, as an informational item. There were three main concerns:

Concern: The fact that there is not 100% neighborhood approval

Answer: The ordinance requires only 50%, while the neighborhood plan requires 60%

Concern: Commercial Land Use should not be in the neighborhood plan

Answer: The Neighborhood Planning Process Resolution requires that you do not exclude the commercial properties from the neighborhood plan

Concern: The residents want the set backs in the General Plan to supercede the Centennial Plan along Las Vegas Blvd. in their district

Answer: The Neighborhood Plan is recommending a height limit of 60 feet on commercial properties along Las Vegas Blvd, which complies with the city Zoning Code. The General Plan requires height setbacks for commercial properties adjacent to residential properties. The Centennial plan, which overlaps in this area, has no height limitations.

Some of the Planning Team members are going to address these concerns and get back to the Planning Commissioners either personally or by letter prior to the next Planning Commission meeting on November 15, 2001.

ITEM 8: RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON THE STATUS OF GRANTS RECEIVED AND APPLIED FOR

The grant just closed out was for the Historic Preservation Video and companion brochures. The contract between the City and the State for the grant that was just received for \$47,500 will go to the City Council on November 21, 2001. Frank will be working on putting together contracts for the consultant.

Bob Stoldal directed staff to contact TV Channel 2 to find out how often the public service spots are running. Dorothy Wright inquired about having the public service spots also run on Channel 4, Bob Stoldal said he would look into it.

ITEM 9: PUBLIC COMMENTS

Daniel Ross asked if the Commission was going to place a Railroad Cottage next the Post Office?

Bob Stoldal replied by explaining that the Transportation Center will be moved to another location and that area would be converted into an Art/Cultural/Historic area.

There was discussion within the City to have the County or Yesco make a copy of the Welcome to Las Vegas sign and move it downtown. The Centennial Commission voted a resolution to send to the County and City to have the sign stay where it is. This will come before the Historic Preservation Commission also for their opinion about moving the sign.

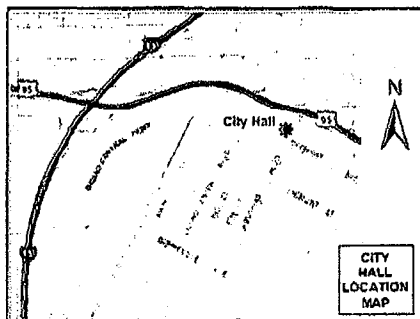
ITEM 10: SET NEXT MEETING DATE/ADJOURNMENT
