COUNCILMAN BARLOW made an announcement on behalf of EDGAR PATINO, Nevada Energy, who will be opening an expo at the East Las Vegas Community Center, 215 North Eastern Avenue, Saturday, July 11th from noon to 4:00 p.m. The agency will help pay past-due bills up to \$350 and cover any continuing repairs. He listed the various agencies that will be available to give assistance. He pointed out there are income requirements that need to be met.
