MAYOR GOODMAN invited JORGE CERVANTES, Director of Public Works, MICHAEL HOLLOWAY, President-Elect of the Nevada Chapter of the American Public Works Association (APWA), SAM TOLMAN and ROY DAVIS to the podium. MR. CERVANTES stated that the City had received two awards from the APWA for two recently completed projects: the Buckskin/Cliff Shadows Equestrian Park and the Hoover/Casino Center Streetscape. MR. HOLLOWAY recognized the City's commitment to top quality public works projects, noting that the City was receiving awards for projects that cost less than \$10 million. He also recognized the many other parties that participated in these projects.

SAM TOLMAN, Project Manager, recognized the efforts of the projects consultant and stated it had been a pleasure to work with the City and the County on the project. ROBERT NELSON and JAY JOHNSON appeared on behalf of Kaniel Construction and MS. JOHNSON thanked WLB for the great design. ROY DAVIS, Clark County Public Works, noted that Clark County had installed some of the Buckskin/Cliff Shadows Equestrian Parks infrastructure and also thanked the City for the opportunity to participate. STEVE TRYON, Bureau of Land Management (BLM), stated that the BLM manages a program where the proceeds from the sale of federal land provides funding to local jurisdictions for parks and trails. He noted that this project is the result of the successful partnership between the BLM and the City.
